Information for Parents

- TJHS maintains high academic expectations, encourages students to participate in a range of opportunities and has a supportive discipline and welfare structure.
- Year 7 Extension Class placements will be offered to successful Year 6 students (for Year 7 2025) based on a number of identification measures including: -
 - 2025 Year 7 Extension Class Entrance Assessment
 - Student Portfolio and handwritten student application letter
 - Primary School Teacher nomination
- Parents/carers can register an Expression of Interest by completing the google form accompanied with a payment of \$25 to covers the Extension Class Assessment
- The primary school principal or their delegate will need to complete the “2025 Year 7 Extension Class Primary School Form” and forward it by email to TJHS
- **Closing date for Student Portfolio and Year 7 Extension Class Primary School Form submission is 24 May 2024.**
- 2025 Year 7 Extension Class Entrance Assessment will be held on Tuesday 25 June 2024
- Information about the Assessment will be emailed to registered applicants after 24 May 2024
- All applicants will be emailed the Assessment results during the week beginning 29 July 2024

Student Portfolio

Each applicant will be required to submit a Student Portfolio. The Portfolio will include: -

- 1) The Student Portfolio Cover page which can be located in the 2025 Year 7 Extension Class Information Package.
- 2) A copy of Year 5 NAPLAN results.
- 3) A student handwritten one-page letter of application outlining their involvement and achievement in school and extracurricular activities over the last two years. This may include leadership, external academic competitions results, e.g., ICAS competitions, participation in sport and performing arts. PLEASE DO NOT SEND COPIES OF CERTIFICATES.
- 4) 2025 Year 7 Extension Class Primary School Form which is to be completed by the student's school and emailed to The Jannali High School.

2025 Year 7 Extension Class Entrance Assessment

- The Year 7 Extension Assessment will consist of questions for general reasoning across the areas of: -
 - Reading and Language - multiple choice
 - Mathematical Reasoning and Vocabulary - multiple choice
 - Writing task
- On the day of the Assessment students will be asked to arrive at TJHS by 9:00am. The test will finish at 12:00pm.
