UCAT stands for University Clinical Aptitude Test. The UCAT is a 2-hour long computer-based exam that is required to gain entry into most medicine and dentistry courses across Australia, New Zealand and the UK.

- Start UCAT preparation asap.
- **1st March:** Register and select your testing date. Click [here](#) for more information.
- **17th May:** UCAT registration closes.
- **3rd July to 12th August:** UCAT Testing Period.
- **Early September:** UCAT results delivered to universities.
- **Late September:** Deadline for applying to universities.
- **October – January:** Interview offers released.
- **November – January:** Interviews conducted.
- **January:** Universities release offers.
