<u>Study Work Grow – '3 Scholarships for Artistic</u> Students'

The Marten Bequest Scholarships – these scholarships, worth \$50,000, give you the chance to explore, study, and develop your artistic skills through interstate or overseas travel.

Samstag Scholarships – this scholarship provides visual artists with institutional fees for one academic year of study, a \$70,000 tax free allowance, and covers travel expenses to a leading international art school of your choice.

Sydney Conservatorium of Music Scholarships – the Sydney Conservatorium of Music awards up to \$2 million worth in scholarships to students every year, in both merit and equity categories.

Study Work Grow - Top Scholarships for Students Experiencing Financial Difficulty

If you're facing financial disadvantage and are looking for a scholarship to help, Study Work Grow have put together the following list:

<u>University of Newcastle Ma & Morley Scholarship Program</u> – this scholarship has a special category for people who have faced educational disadvantage, including financial difficulties. It's

worth up to \$75,000 and includes a China immersion experience.

<u>Griffith Chancellor's Scholarships</u> – worth between \$11,000 and \$22,000, these scholarships are designed to help students who have faced financial and educational struggles.

<u>UAC Equity Scholarships</u> – a large suite of scholarships available from many different unis designed to help students from low socioeconomic backgrounds.

<u>Deakin Student Support Scholarship</u> – offers up to \$10,000 per year for students facing financial difficulty.

<u>SATAC Equity Scholarships</u> – scholarships for students in financial need studying at the University of South Australia.
