University Admissions Centre (UAC)

HOW TO APPLY FOR UNI

On 5 April, UAC will email UAC PINs to all NSW and ACT Year 12 students. You'll need this PIN to apply through UAC and to view your ATAR at the end of the year. Keep it in a safe and secure place and don't give it to anyone else.

When you apply through UAC, you'll need to enter your **Unique Student Identifier (USI)**. Your USI is your lifelong education number and all

higher education students must have one. You can't get a HECS-HELP loan without it. If you're studying a VET course you might already have one. Click [here](#) to **apply for your USI** or check if you have one.

Some degrees for example medicine and law, have additional selection criteria. Be sure to check with the relevant institution.

Applying For Uni Through UAC

Applications for semester 1, 2024 open at 9am on Wed 5 Apr 2023. An early bird application fee of approximately \$80 applies until 30th September. This cost then rises to \$200. This six month window allows students to create an application which allows UAC to offer them a place at university.

The UAC portal also allows students to apply for the Educational Access Scheme, School Recommendation Scheme and Equity Scholarships. See below for more information.

Educational Access Scheme

The Educational Access Scheme (EAS) aims to help students who have experienced significant educational disadvantage receive an offer to university. To apply for EAS you must be able to demonstrate that, as a result of circumstances beyond your control or choosing, your studies were negatively affected during Year 11 and/or Year 12. Participating institutions may award ATAR adjustment factors based on the assessment of the disadvantage. Categories of disadvantage include:

- Disrupted schooling
- Financial hardship
- Severe family disruption
- Excessive family responsibilities
- English Language disabilities

- Personal Illness/disability
- Refugee status
- School environment
- Socio-economic indexes for areas

Proof of disadvantage is required. Applications that require an Educational Impact Statement must be brought to the Careers Office for processing. Click [here](#) for more information on EAS.

School Recommendation Scheme

SRS is an early offer program administered by UAC for Year 12 students. They do this by using criteria other than (or in addition to) the ATAR.

All Year 12 students are eligible to apply. 14 institutions offer early admission via SRS and each assess on different criteria. Click [here](#) for more information on participating institutions and how to apply.

Equity Scholarships

Equity Scholarships are awarded to students from low socio-economic backgrounds, particularly those who receive Centrelink income support payments such as ABSTUDY, Austudy, Youth Allowance, JobSeeker Payment, Disability Support Pension, Parenting Payment (Single) or the Carer Payment.

You can apply for an Equity Scholarship if applying for admission to a UAC participating institution:

- through UAC for undergraduate or
- directly to an institution

Early Entry/Admission

Information on Early Entry for universities will be published in the newsletter as they are finalised. Click on the universities to view their application process.

- [Charles Sturt University](#) (CSU) – Open now. Round 1 applications close 7th April. Get in early to maximise your chances of an early offer.
- [Australian National University](#) (ANU) – Open now. Applications close 15th May.
- [University of New England](#) (UNE) – Open now. Applications close 15th September.
- [Notre Dame](#) (Early Offer) – 1st May – 30th September – Offers made approximately 8 weeks after submission (except for nursing and education). Apply early to maximise your chances of being made an offer.
