MedEntry UCAT Preparation

The UCAT (University Clinical Aptitude Test) is required for entry into most medicine and dentistry courses across Australia. Students who wish to enter such courses will need to sit UCAT in July-August 2024. Year 11 students who are interested in medicine or dentistry have just under one year before their test. The best way to prepare for UCAT is by distributed practice over several months. MedEntry offers a free UCAT practice exam with feedback and solutions. We can also arrange access to the entire MedEntry platform to demonstrate to your students, and an online information session about UCAT.
