University Admissions Centre (UAC)

About UAC - REPEAT

The Universities Admissions Centre (UAC) processes applications for admission to most undergraduate courses at participating institutions (mainly located in NSW and the ACT). UAC also:

- processes applications for admission to many postgraduate courses
- calculates and provides the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) to NSW HSC students
- processes applications for Educational Access Schemes (EAS)
- processes applications for some Equity Scholarships (ES)
- processes applications for some Schools Recommendation Schemes (SRS).

2025 admissions

Applications for 2025 entry opened on 3 April for domestic students.

UAC emailed UAC PINs to all NSW HSC students on 3 April. Students will need their NESA student number and their UAC PIN to apply through UAC.

Access schemes

Applications for the [Schools Recommendation Scheme \(SRS\)](#) and the [Educational Access Scheme \(EAS\)](#) are also now open.

Course preferences

Not all courses are available to select within your application. However, you can still submit an application with at least one preference and then come back later to list additional courses when they become available. Universities have until 1st August to have all 2025 courses available for selection in the application.

Starting an application: essential info

This year, students need the following details to start their UAC application:

- **Personal email address:** For security reasons, when students start their application they will need to register with a personal email address and a password. They'll then be sent an email to validate their details. Once they've done that, they will use their email address and password to log in to their application.
- **Year 12 student number and UAC PIN:** *NSW and ACT students* – UAC PINs were emailed to NSW students on 3rd April. If any students didn't receive this email, please [call UAC](#). You also need to register a personal email address in your [NESA Students Online](#) account.
- **Unique Student Identifier (USI):** At the request of institutions, this is now mandatory for domestic applicants. Students can quickly and easily [create their USI or check if they already have one](#).
