University Admissions Centre (UAC)

The <u>Universities Admissions Centre (UAC)</u> processes applications for admission to most undergraduate courses at participating institutions (mainly located in NSW and the ACT). UAC also:

- processes applications for admission to many postgraduate courses
- calculates and provides the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) to NSW HSC students
- processes applications for Educational Access Schemes (EAS)
- processes applications for some Equity Scholarships (ES)
- processes applications for some Schools Recommendation Schemes (SRS).

2026 Admissions

Applications for 2026 entry are now open for domestic students.

UAC emailed UAC PINs to all NSW HSC students on **2nd April 2025**. Students will need their NESA student number and their UAC PIN to apply through UAC.

Access schemes

Applications for the <u>Schools Recommendation</u> <u>Scheme (SRS)</u> and the <u>Educational Access Scheme</u> (EAS) are also now open.
