STUDENT INFORMATION

ALL STUDENTS PLEASE NOTE:

- 1 Students are required to wear full school uniform during the examination period.
- 2 All exams will be held in the Hall except for the Music Aural Exam in Music Room 2. Students with Special Provisions will be provided with a timetable that indicates the rooms for their exams.
- 3 All students should arrive at least 10 minutes before the starting time of the exam. Exam attendance is recorded by completing an Attendance Slip at the beginning of each exam. If late, please report to the office before going to the hall.
- 4 Use only black pens. Pencils, rulers, calculators etc might also be required. All stationary is to be in a clear plastic container and if you bring a drink bottle it must be clear and have no label.
- 5 When in the examination room, **students must remove watches** and place them in clear view on the examination table.
- 6 All writing paper is provided.
- 7 Students must remain in the examination room for the entire duration of each examination.
- 8 There is to be no communication between students while inside the examination room. The borrowing of equipment or material is prohibited.
- 9 Mobile phones or any other form of electronic device are not permitted in the examination room and will be collected and stored at the office during the exam. They can be picked up at the conclusion of the exam.
- 10 If a student is unable to attend an examination due to illness, the school should be notified by telephone as soon as possible. A doctor's certificate is required to explain the absence. This certificate must be presented to the Deputy Principal or the relevant Head Teacher as soon as the student returns to school.
- 11 Any student who is absent from an examination must report to the relevant Head Teacher immediately after the illness/misadventure to arrange an alternative time for missed exams. Failure on the part of the student to arrange an alternative time will result in a zero for the examination for that student.

Note: Thursday 26th September has been set aside for catch up exams.
