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2023 High Potential & Gifted DANCE PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP and AUDITION INFORMATION

Selection/Audition Process

- Dance scholarships will be offered to successful Year 6 students (for Year 7 2022) based on their written application and practical audition.
- The application form must be completed by the parents/carers and returned to The Jannali High School (TJHS) by Friday, 24th June 2022.
- All information, experience or items mentioned in the application form must be supported by evidence and documentation / copies included.
- The primary school principal or their delegate will need to complete page 2 of the "Scholarship and Audition Application" and forward it by email to TJHS.
- Information about the audition procedure, including time and date, will be forwarded to you by email after you have returned the application form to TJHS.
- Auditions will be held the week commencing on Monday, 25th July 2022.
- Successful applicants will be notified the week commencing Monday, 1 August 2022.

Information for Parents

- TJHS maintains high academic expectations, encourages students to participate in a range of opportunities and has a supportive discipline and welfare structure.
- In addition, dance students will be required to wear appropriate clothing for rehearsal.
- Dance ensemble students will be charged for costumes
- School hours are from 8:40am to 3:00pm for all students (Thursday 2:45pm). There will be some additional commitments for Dance rehearsals outside these hours.

Scholarship information

- The total value of dance scholarship is \$200 and must be used during Years 7 and 8.
- The scholarship is valid while the student remains enrolled at TJHS.
- The scholarship may be used for such things as school endorsed tutoring, instrument hire, costume rental, subsidising school excursions, purchase of school uniform, ensemble fees, subject contributions, participation in dance performance and extra-curricula activities and other needs as agreed to by the Principal (a special request is required).
- The scholarship is not provided as a cash payment, however you may access the funds at any time during each year.

Preparing for your Dance audition

- Appropriate dance attire is required.
- Jewellery should not be worn.
- Hair should be tied back from your face.
- Students will take part in an individual activity (teacher led warm-up and technical skills).
- Students are to prepare a short dance sequence to music of their choice (approx. 2 mins in duration)
- Students are to bring a copy of the music with them on CD, iPhone, iPad.
