



2024 High Potential & Gifted DRAMA PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP and AUDITION INFORMATION

Selection/Audition Process

- Drama scholarships will be offered to successful Year 6 students (for Year 7 2023) based on their written application and practical audition.
- The application form must be completed by the parents/carers and returned to The Jannali High School (TJHS) by Friday, 23 June 2023.
- All information, experience or items mentioned in the application form must be supported by evidence and documentation / copies included.
- The primary school principal or their delegate will need to complete page 2 of the "Scholarship and Audition Application" and forward it by email to TJHS.
- Information about the audition procedure, including time and date, will be forwarded to you by email after you have returned the application form to TJHS.
- Auditions will be held the week commencing Monday, 26 July 2023.
- Successful applicants will be notified the week commencing Monday, 7 August 2023.

Information for Parents

- TJHS maintains high academic expectations, encourages students to participate in a range of opportunities and has a supportive discipline and welfare structure.
- TJHS requires students to wear full school uniform at all times. In addition, drama students will be required to wear appropriate clothing for rehearsal.
- Drama ensemble students will be charged a fee, to subsidise the costs of equipment, photocopying, technology and costume upkeep etc.
- School hours are from 8:40am to 3:00pm for all students (Thursday 2:45pm). There will be some additional commitments for Drama rehearsals outside these hours.

Scholarship information

- Students successful in gaining a Drama scholarship may be placed in a High Potential & Gifted Drama class in Year 7 and 8 for 2024 and 2025.
- The total value of drama scholarship is \$200 and must be used during Years 7 and 8.
- The scholarship is valid while the student remains enrolled at TJHS.
- The scholarship may be used for such things as school endorsed tutoring, instrument hire, costume rental, subsidising school excursions, purchase of school uniform, ensemble fees, subject contributions, participation in drama performance and extra-curricular activities and other needs as agreed to by the Principal (a special request is required).
- The scholarship is not provided as a cash payment, however you may access the funds at any time during each year.

Preparing for your Drama audition

- Appropriate drama attire (black shirt and pants) is required.
- Jewellery should not be worn, and hair should be tied back from your face.
- Students will participate in a range of ensemble activities which examine collaboration, improvisation and technical skills.
- Students are to prepare and perform a short monologue (approx. 2 mins). Students must consider the physicality and vocal dynamics of the character they are performing. Short scripts may be sourced online.
