SOCIAL MEDIA / MOBILE DEVICE USE GUIDELINES

As students begin to interact online it is important to consider the school & DEC guidelines about ONLINE behaviour. <u>TJHS promotes the responsible use of all social media programs</u> <u>through encouraging our students to</u>:

- \checkmark Be considerate and polite online at all times
- ✓ Be aware that what you write online is being received by another person and can be recorded
- Consider what you say before you say it it'll be on the web for a long time!
- Respect the fact that you are not to take photos or make video recordings of any individual or group of students without the express written permission of each individual.
- Report any concerns you have about your online conversations with your parents/Year Adviser or Deputy Principal
- ✓ Ensure that YOUR behaviour is always respectful of others!
- ✓ Avoid getting carried away while typing don't send a response when you are annoyed or angry
- ✓ Remember that the Police may need to be contacted if behaviour is not managed in a respectful manner.

Any behaviour contrary to these directions will be considered an infringement of the school's "Code of Behaviour" and dealt with formally via the school's welfare and discipline procedures.
