Dear Parents/Carers

During Terms 3 and 4, the structure of The Jannali High School and Partner Schools Enrichment Program will change. The reason for the new structure is to provide students who have already participated in the original 18-week Enrichment Program in Terms 1 and 2, the opportunity to take part in additional Enrichment Workshops. It also enables new students who have a passion for a particular discipline, to attend a shorter, 4-week workshop.

Years 4, 5 and 6 students may elect to enrol in one or all of the 4-week workshops. There is a \$120 fee for participation in each 4-week course. Payment needs to be made at the school prior to commencement of the workshop by cash, cheque, EFTPOS or online via the school's website.

The following workshops will be offered on a **Thursday during Semester 2 in 2018:**

Term 3

Scientific Conundrum

(Every Thursday from 2/08/18 – 23/08/18)

Scientists ask difficult questions about various phenomena. Do you love science, conducting experiments and asking that question that begins with ... How...?



In this hands-on workshop you will be busy with experiments which investigate the exciting areas of chemistry and physics. Find out the facts about the world we live in whilst having fun.

You will also participate in this year's Science Festival at the Australian Museum. This is a fantastic festival where students are emerged in scientific demonstrations, hands-on activities and Science shows. This excursion will incur an extra cost of \$25 which includes transport and interactive shows.



If you are a budding mad scientist, then this workshop is for you!

Exploring Mythology

(Thursday 30/08/18 –20/09/18)

Behind every culture there is a fascinating story that unlocks the mysteries of the world. During this four week workshop you will:

- Come on a journey to Ancient Egypt as we examine the life of a pharaoh, their gods and goddesses and their eternal quest for immortality.
- Take to the sea as we learn about the nautical Norse and Viking explorers, and take to the sky as we learn about the gods and goddesses they worshipped.
- From Pegasus to Poseidon, look at the rich mythology of Ancient Greece and Rome.
- Discover the mythological beliefs of Ireland.
- Delve into the world of African legends and visit the Far East.



If you love exploring the mythical world, you will love this workshop.

Term 4

Forensic Science

(Every Thursday from 25/10/18 –15/11/18)

Scientists believe it is impossible for someone to commit a crime without leaving something behind or taking something with them.

If traces of evidence can be found, this may provide proof to bring the criminal to justice. It's the evidence left behind that is the true witness to a crime. Forensic scientists convert these clues, using the latest technology, into evidence admissible in a court of law.



In this course you will investigate such evidence as blood splatters and blood types, fingerprints, hairs, fibres from clothes, tiny traces of chemicals and handwriting clues in the case of forgery. This course is packed full of intrigue and solutions discovered through careful experimentation.

Join us for an introduction to the fascinating world of Forensics.

Your parents will have organised your transport to and from The Jannali High School. Make sure you have talked to them about this and that you understand the arrangements clearly.


What do I need to bring?
